Enable Trust is a Special School Multi Academy Trust in South Gloucestershire. Our schools are each designated and run to support children and young people with significant Special Educational Needs and Disabilities. They are:

New Siblands School, Thornbury: severe learning difficulties (SLD) and profound and multiple learning difficulties (PMLD)

Culverhill School, Yate: Complex Learning Difficulties (CLD)

All our children and young people have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).

Responsibility for the educational provision for children with EHCPs lies with the Local Authority. Each school in Enable Trust carefully considers all consultations from local authorities and responds objectively to the request for a place. This process considers all of the needs of the child as stated in their EHCP and the school's ability to meet them. This includes consideration of their developmental learning needs, health and safety requirements and how these might impact on others within our school community. Where we do not feel that we can meet a child's needs for any reason, we will engage the Local Authority in active dialogue to resolve the issue. As a Trust we strive to deliver positive educational outcomes for every child through a high quality and holistic education.
