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Enable Trust aims and values

- **To empower and promote the SEND voice across the systems (local, regional and national)** – We want to ensure the needs of pupils with additional needs are recognised and understood by our mainstream colleagues.
- **To attract, develop and share leadership and expertise in SEND** – We aim to do this through high quality outreach support. We offer training in a variety of key areas such as supporting pupils with communication difficulties, sensory processing difficulties and autism. We wish to further develop partnership between special schools and mainstream schools in a strategic, planned and transparent way.
- **To secure the most effective EHC provision for children and young people from the earliest years through to post-19** – We want to empower our mainstream colleagues and build confidence to ensure high quality provision for pupils with additional needs.
- **To pioneer excellence in staff and pupil achievement and well-being** – We aim to do this by supporting staff in mainstream settings feel more motivated and enthusiastic in their day-to-day work with pupils with additional needs and ensuring the mental health and holistic needs of those pupils are met.

The staff at Enable Trust have extensive knowledge and experience in working with pupils with a range of different learning difficulties and disabilities. ETHOS is our outreach programme which aims to assist our mainstream colleagues to increase their confidence, skills and understanding in supporting pupils within their mainstream setting.

We are able to offer specific outreach support for individual pupils and give advice on how to ensure these pupils make progress. We are able to offer a variety of different packages including phone consultations, onsite visits and onsite staff training. The service caters for pupils with a range of additional needs from 2 to 19 years.

In addition to the services and training listed we are able to design and co-ordinate bespoke programmes specific to your setting's needs.

ETHOS Training offers

ASD

Staff at Enable Trust have a vast knowledge of supporting pupils with ASD. This training session will provide staff with some basic understanding of what autism is and how staff can meet the needs of pupils with autism within their mainstream classroom.

Behaviour

At Enable Trust we write positive behaviour support plans for some of our pupils who display dysregulated behaviours. We write these plans with consent and input from parents so that all staff working with those children are aware of triggers, proactive and reactive strategies and any physical intervention that may be required. Staff from the positive behaviour support team can help mainstream schools write these plans for specific pupils if needed.

Communication

Staff at Enable Trust are skilled in supporting pupils with a range of communication difficulties. We can offer training on early communication skills such as the use of augmentative and alternative communication, PECS and intensive interaction.

Manual Handling

Enable Trust has two accredited manual handling trainers who can deliver training at your setting or at one of our schools. We also offer ongoing telephone/email advice as required.

Reading and phonics

Many pupils with additional needs struggle with the traditional route of phonics and reading. At Enable Trust we have a range of reading strategies we use with our pupils. Our skilled staff can provide training and advice on strategies to use within your mainstream setting.

SEMH

At Enable Trust we use a mixture of Thrive and ELSA techniques to support our pupils with their social, emotional and mental health needs. Our SEMH leads can deliver basic training on how to support any pupils who have needs in this area.

Sensory processing difficulties

Many pupils with additional needs also have sensory processing needs which can affect how they feel and act. We can offer general advice and training on what is sensory processing and ideas for sensory regulating activities.
